Unlike students who live in the cities, students' livelihood for those in the rural area is more difficult and they face tougher learning conditions. Most of them have to work alongside their parents after school, instead of going out or take extra lessons. As most rural parents make their living by farming which requires a lot of manual labor, children usually are required to work together with their family starting from secondary school.

- gender discrimination most parents give priority to their sons for school over their daughters, because they think girls will leave the family after getting married, which does not help the family much;
- entering into marriage too early before they are mature enough for it.

Community workers in Vietnam would like to partner with charity to:


- help rural area develop by teaching them how to grow crops, raise livestock and do business effectively;
