

COVID-19 Medical Aid (Vietnam)

COVID cases in Vietnam, in a matter of two months, was multiplied by 8 folds and registered about 80,000 new cases a day in February 2022. Local government mandated people contacted with the virus to stay home. Hospital resources are prioritised with only those that are in dire circumstances to get admitted to hospitals while less severe cases do not get access to medical attention.

In light of the medical shortage in the village area of Vietnam and the economic needs, His Field Foundation procured medication in Hanoi and worked with local partners to transfer these medical supplies to area outside the city, where medicine was hardly accessible. With the help of local volunteer (note), those medicine was carried to families and patients affected by the virus.
